What should children do?

TALK AND SHARE THEIR WORRIES

If you are worried about anything, either at home or in school you can tell any adult in school.

They may or may not need to speak to your teacher, Mrs Cox or Mr Creighton.

You can also talk to other trusted adults for example your parents/carers, the police, NSPCC, Social Worker etc.
